The Textile Centre of Excellence is running its second 'Skills Bootcamp' programme for textile manufacturers.

Developed specifically to meet the needs of West Yorkshire textile businesses, graduates of the programme will be ready to start work in the industry or progress in their existing roles. We'd love to hear from businesses that want to create a bespoke learning experience for their staff or new employees.

The programme consists of 10 training dates, delivering core modules that have been specifically designed by industry experts and textile manufacturing business leaders. Sessions involve theoretical study with practical site visits to support learning.
